Asannagar MMT College, Nadia took the initiative in Dengue Awareness and Precaution activities in the Adopted Village (College Para). Efforts will be taken to control the breeding of mosquitoes by removing stagnant water and sprinkling disinfectant in the Village. Dengue fever has become a threat to the country, especially during the rainy seasons. To facilitate the curbing of this disease, 22 NSS volunteers of Asannagar MMT College were involved in a dengue prevention activity inside the Village. The volunteers were divided into two groups and were allotted a specific location in the Village. The volunteers were instructed to identify places within the village where Aedes mosquitoes were likely to breed. They were provided with disposable gloves, masks and disinfectant. The students screened the village for stagnant water and tried to eliminate them. They emptied and removed empty cartons and containers filled with water. They also sprinkled disinfectants on the ground and places where complete removal of cartons was not possible. They made sure that the disinfectants (bleaching powder) were not sprinkled in regions where fish and other aquatic animals would be affected. The students gathered after completing their tasks and shared their experiences. They also practiced a skit program to be performed for the community to create awareness of the prevention of dengue.
